Professional Concentrations:

Community Health – prepares students to pursue careers in staff and administration positions within government and not-profit organizations, hospitals, health insurance companies, wellness programs, mental health facilities, sports medicine facilities, long-term care facilities, and other health related institutions. Students can also prepare for graduate programs in Public Health including the MPH at Daemen College, Community Health Education, Healthcare Administration, and more.

Complementary and Alternative Health – prepares students for holistic health care careers in consultation, holistic health education, and program development, in a variety of areas related to complementary and alternative health. Students can also prepare for graduate programs in Acupuncture, Chiropractic, and Naturopathic medicine, or certificate based programs in massage therapy, homeopathic medicine and other areas.

Health and Fitness – prepares students for careers in fitness and wellness consultation, as personal trainers, health and fitness instructors, strength and conditioning coaches in a variety of settings such as health clinics, fitness centers, nursing homes, sports facilities, community centers and more. Students can also prepare for graduate programs in Athletic Training (including the MS in Athletic Training at Daemen College), Exercise Science or Physiology.

Graduate School Preparation:

Within each professional concentration, students are well-prepared to enter graduate programs in Public Health, Community Health Education, Exercise Science, Athletic Training, Healthcare Administration, Acupuncture, Chiropractic and other holistic practices, and more.
