



First-time, Full-time, Degree-Seeking Freshmen







A fall cohort refers to first-time full-time degree-seeking freshmen who enrolled at Daemen university during a given fall semester.



First-time, Full-time, Degree-Seeking Freshmen










Retention and Graduation Rates by Pell Grant Status






Daemen University Exit Survey Results



The Exit Survey is given to students who formally withdraw from the college. 588 students completed the survey between September 2018 and July 2024.


Enrollment in Developmental Courses






Retention Rates by Course and Grade Status

Note: The above data show fall-to-fall retention rates for first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students based on whether the student took one or more developmental courses







